The event took place at the premises of the [Wohnungsbaugenossenschaft Berolina eG](#). Berolina has been supporting AMPO in its work for many years. With lots of photos and some video material they talked about the various impressions they gathered on the trip in January. Burkina Faso has changed, but sadly not for the better. The risk of terrorist activity is on the increase and as a result the entire country is plagued with more violence leading to even more poverty. The colleagues started with some photographs illustrating the extreme poverty and pollution which can be seen throughout the country. In the middle of all this AMPO appears as an oasis of peace and order. The AMPO facilities are striving to deal with the current situation and ensure a better future for many adults and children. In spite of the circumstances, we continue to believe in AMPO and the work our colleagues in Burkina Faso are doing every day.

She also held a talk with about 200 children at the local primary school. The children listened attentively and asked some very interesting questions. Talks like this are so important to make children aware of the reality of people's lives in other countries.
